



## TERMS AND CONDITIONS/OFFICIAL RULES FOR CREAM OF THE CROP COMPETITION

1. **ELIGIBILITY:** The Cream of the Crop Competition PowerPoint (the PowerPoint Competition) is open to secondary and TAFE students and undergraduates and postgraduate students (under 30) enrolled in NSW secondary schools and/or tertiary education institutions during the Competition Period.  
The Cream of the Crop Video Competition PowerPoint (the Video Competition) is open to secondary students enrolled in NSW secondary schools during the Competition Period.  
Employees of the Project Organiser and their immediate families together with agencies and/or organisations associated with this Competition are ineligible to enter.
2. **PROJECT ORGANISER:** The Competition is organised by Dairy Youth Australia Inc. P.O. Box 20, JAMBEROO NSW 2533, ABN 39 055 985 661.
3. **AGREEMENT TO OFFICIAL RULES:** Participation in the Competition constitutes each Entrant's full and unconditional agreement to and acceptance of these Official Rules and decisions of the Project Organiser which are final and binding in all respects.
4. **COMPETITION PERIOD:** The Competition begins on Monday 1st August 2011 and ends on Thursday 1st December 2011 at 5:00pm. Each entry must be received on a USB or CD electronic format by the Project organiser during this period to be eligible for a prize.
5. **ENTRY:** Students may enter as both individuals or as members of teams of up to three people. There is no limit on the number of entries. All secondary school and tertiary institution team members must be from the same Year Cohort e.g. all Year 11. All team members must be from the same educational institution. All entries must be accompanied by an official entry form completed in full, signed by all entrants and countersigned by a teacher/supervisor from the same educational institution.
6. **OWNERSHIP:** All entries will become the property of the Project Organiser, Dairy Youth Australia Inc upon receipt by the Project Organiser. Submission of any Entry constitutes Entrant's consent to assign and transfer irrevocably to Project Organiser any and all rights, title and interest in the Entry, without limitation, including all copyrights and grants to Project Organiser and its affiliates an irrevocable right to print, reproduce, publish, use, edit, adapt, display, broadcast and/or modify the Entry in any way, in any and all media now know or hereinafter developed without compensation to the Entrant.
7. **USE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION:** Personal information submitted while participating in the Competition will be used primarily to contact selected finalists and potential winners but Entrant grants to Project Organiser an irrevocable right to use such information as inclusions in newsworthy items for the purpose of advertising and promotion of the Competition without any or additional compensation or review.
8. **JUDGING:** The Competition is a contest of skill. Entries judged to be the most creative and original in each category will be deemed to be the winning entry. Judging will take place on or about Friday 2nd December 2011.  
The 12 finalists will receive official notification of their selection through their nominated contact details from Art4Agriculture on, or before, Saturday, 17th December 2011. Finalist names and details will be publicly announced on the Art4Agriculture website [www.Art4Agriculture.com.au](http://www.Art4Agriculture.com.au) on Sunday, 18th December 2011.
9. **WINNERS:** The winning entries will be announced at an Awards and Presentation Day to be held during the Sydney Royal Easter Show 2012.

In the event of a query or dispute the Project Organiser's decision shall be final.
